Costanza Emanuelli was born in Florence (Tuscany) and studied there to PhD level. She has worked in San Francisco, Ferrara, Rome, Sassari, and Boston before arriving in Bristol in 2005. She has recently been awarded a British Heart Foundation (BHF) Chair in Cardiovascular Science at the University of Bristol and is an honorary Professor at the Imperial College of London. She is the Bristol coordinator and co-deputy of a BHF centre of Regenerative Medicine, which involves Edinburgh (coordinating centre), Bristol, the Imperial College and the Kings College London. She is also PI in the Leducq Transatlantic Network on vascular microRNAs and in European and UK grants. She is a Fellow of the American Heart Association (FAHA) and part of the editorial boards of *Circ Res*, *ATVB* and *Vascular Pharmacology*, as well as an Academic Editor for *Plos One*. She is also part of national and international grant panels. Her background is in pharmacology and therapeutic angiogenesis. She had the privilege to be part of the team of Jeff Isner (for the last year of his life as he died prematurely in 2001) in Boston. That was "the lab" if you were interested in reparative angiogenesis by gene and cell therapy, as he was pioneering the field.
