I will discuss our work in two different areas to improve candidate vaccines. In the first example I will show data on the use of the Fc tag to stimulate immunity of the influenza hemagglutinin and the role of protein oligomerization in the outcome. In the second I will show our data on the assembly of picornavirus VLPs, predominantly for Foot and Mouth Disease Virus, and some aspects of virus assembly revealed by these studies.
