ICGEB GRANT APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Early career scientists (PhD students and postdoctoral researchers) who are [ICGEB member states](#) nationals currently residing outside of UAE are invited to submit abstracts for presentation at the “Nuclear and Cytoplasmic Machines at Work” workshop to be held 8-10 April 2019, at the New York University Abu Dhabi campus. Ten early career scientists from the applicants will be invited to present their work at the workshop and will receive an ICGEB-funded grant of €500 to offset their travel and accommodation expenses.

Applicants must submit the following all in one pdf document to pp69@nyu.edu

- a cover page including the applicant’s name, career stage, affiliation, nationality as per travel document, and country of residence
- a cover letter of no more than 500 words explaining the applicants research interests
- A short abstract of the presentation of no more than 300 words and up to one display figure

Additionally, the applicant must arrange that a reference letter be sent separately by the research group leader endorsing the application. The letter should be sent to pp69@nyu.edu

Complete applications must be received by 3 December 2018 for consideration. Incomplete applications, or applications received after the deadline will not be considered
