DISCOVER TRIESTE
WALKING TOUR

Meet and greet with English speaking guide.

Visit the main sights such as the magnificent Piazza Unità, Europe's largest square overlooking the sea, the Rive, the old town and the Habsburg part of the city.

MUSEO REVOLTELLA

Meet and greet with English speaking guide.

The Revoltella Museum in Trieste, an elegant urban residence in Renaissance style, was built between 1854 and 1858, designed by the Berliner F. Hitzig, a pupil of Schinkel, at the behest of Baron Pasquale Revoltella, who at his death in 1869 turned it into a museum and left it to the city.

During this century the Revoltella museum was developed in the adjacent Palazzo Brunner, which today houses one of the most important collections of modern art in Italy (works by Hayez, Fattori, De Nittis, Morelli, Palazzi, Nono, Favretto, Bistolfi, Previati, von Stuck, Morandi, Fontana, etc.).

MIRAMARE CASTLE

Meet and greet with English speaking guide.

Private transportation to Miramare Castle, guided visit of the Castle and its park.

Back to Trieste city center.

DUINO CASTLE

Meet and greet with English speaking guide.

Duino Castle, owned by the Princes della Torre e Tasso, was built in 1300 on the ruins of a Roman outpost.

It looks like a composite and massive building overlooking the Gulf of Trieste. Inside, it houses important art masterpieces and refined historical relics. Over the centuries it has hosted many famous people: among others, the poet R.M. Rilke, Elisabeth of Austria (the famous Sissi), Archduke Maximilian of Habsburg and his wife Charlotte of Belgium.

A visit to the castle and its garden allows you to admire the fortepiano played by Franz Liszt, the Palladio staircase, the view of the Gulf of Trieste from the top of the tower, the ramparts overlooking the sea and the Bunker built in 1943 by the German Kriegsmarine.

Private transportation to Duino Castle, guided visit of the Castle and its park.

Back to Trieste city center.
