Scientists and corporate communications experts will present Master classes on communicating science, championing two-way communication, UN event formats (including ERN and Science Fairs), and project examples, with the ultimate goal to build an interface of academics who can disseminate science on a range of topics with a variety of audiences, including journalists. Topics will include:

- Biotechnology for sustainable development
- The role of biotechnology in economic and societal development
- Science and policy: science communication tools and practices
- Implementing change towards responsible research and innovation
- Science communication as social responsibility

- Administrators and communicators from national universities and research institutions in the field of biotechnology
- Journalists involved in the science communication activities

Funding

- Fellowships for 15 participants who are nationals of **ICGEB Member States** residing outside of the Republic of Moldova, covering the accommodation, local transportation and hospitality for the duration of the event, as well as travel reimbursement in the amount of 50% from the total travel cost but not more than 100 Euro will be covered from the ICGEB grant
- For the rest of international participants, organisers will cover the meals, local transportation and preferential rate for lodging in the university campus
